

CLINICAL RATIONALE/JUSTIFICATION FOR SUPPORT SURFACES - POWERED & NON-POWERED

This information is only a guide. Permobil recommends that a clinician experienced in skin/wounds/assessment be consulted to determine if these features are appropriate for the user's particular needs. Permobil provides this information to assist prescribing therapists. Each client should be considered as an individual with specific clinical needs based upon individual assessment.

This guide is intended to assist clinicians with choosing Support Surface features based on the clinical assessment and goals of the client in need. A list of the Permobil Support Surfaces that include each feature is provided to assist in directing the clinician to the specific product for consideration. It is not intended to suggest that the products listed are the most appropriate products to recommend/prescribe for a particular client.

Select a support surface that meets the individual's need for pressure redistribution based on the following factors:

- · Level of immobility and inactivity
- Need to influence microclimate control and shear reduction
- Size and weight of the individual
- Number, severity, and location of existing pressure injuries
- Risk for developing new pressure injuries

Client has risk of skin/tissue breakdown:

ROHO mattress section - Adapt, Adapt 2, Acute, Acute P3, Original Snap Series SRT (Shear Reduction Technology) - Advance, Align, Allay, Adapt, Adapt 2, Acute P3 Dynamic dispersion pressure redistribution - Fusion XC

Foam section with square cuts - Align

Foot pillow - SelectAir Max

Visco topper/heel section - Fusion XC

Zoned surface - Align, Adapt, Adapt 2, Acute P3, Original Snap Series, eMotion, SelectAir Max, Fusion 2K, Fusion XC

Alternating pressure - eMotion, Fusion APT

Pulsation mode - SelectAir Max, Fusion 2K

Low air loss - eMotion, Fusion 2K, SelectAir Max

Client has temperature issues and feels hot much of the time/cannot control their body or wound temperature:

Gel Swirl foam - Allay, Adapt, Adapt 2, Acute P3

ROHO mattress section - Adapt, Adapt 2, Acute, Acute P3, Original Snap Series

Low air loss - eMotion, Fusion 2K, SelectAir Max

Client requires assistance with bed mobility:

Firm perimeter - Align, Allay, Adapt, Adapt 2, Original Snap Series, Fusion 2K, Fusion XC, Fusion APT (Note: Acute P3 has 3" firm perimeter on the base layer of foam, not raised firm perimeter)

Zoned surface - Align, Adapt, Adapt 2, Acute P3, Original Snap Series, eMotion, SelectAir Max, Fusion 2K, Fusion XC **SRT (Shear Reduction Technology)** - Advance, Align, Allay, Adapt, Adapt 2, Acute P3

Client requires additional safety measures when transferring (self-transfer or assisted bed to w/c transfer):

Firm perimeter - Align, Allay, Adapt, Adapt 2, Original Snap Series, Fusion 2K, Fusion XC, Fusion APT (Note: Acute P3 has 3" firm perimeter on the base layer of foam, not raised firm perimeter)

Firmer top foam layer of surface (High resiliency foam layer) - Advance, Align

Firm mattress mode - eMotion, Fusion 2K, SelectAir Max

Client is required to maintain position in upright sitting for ADLs, self-care, etc.:

SRT (Shear Reduction Technology) - Advance, Align, Allay, Adapt, Adapt 2, Acute P3

Zoned surface - Align, Adapt, Adapt 2, Acute P3, Original Snap Series, eMotion, SelectAir Max, Fusion 2K, Fusion XC

Visco topper/heel section - Fusion XC

Upright/Fowler mode - eMotion, Fusion 2K, SelectAir Max

Foot pillow - SelectAir Max

Client slides down the bed throughout the day:

SRT (Shear Reduction Technology) - Advance, Align, Allay, Adapt, Adapt 2, Acute P3

Zoned surface - Align, Adapt, Adapt 2, Acute P3, Original Snap Series, eMotion, SelectAir Max, Fusion 2K, Fusion XC

Visco topper/heel section - Fusion XC

Foot pillow - SelectAir Max

Client uses the head-up and foot-up features of the bed periodically throughout the day:

Accordion cuts on border allowing bending of surface during bed movements - Align, Allay, Adapt, Acute P3 SRT (Shear Reduction Technology) - Advance, Align, Allay, Adapt, Adapt, Adapt 2, Acute P3

Zoned system - Align, Adapt, Adapt 2, Acute P3, Original Snap Series, eMotion, SelectAir Max, Fusion 2K, Fusion XC

Visco topper/heel section - Fusion XC

Foam section with square cuts - Align

Foot pillow - SelectAir Max

ROHO mattress section - Adapt, Adapt 2, Acute, Acute P3, Original Snap Series

Client is using bed with side rails (requires prevention of entrapment):

Firm perimeter - Align, Allay, Adapt, Adapt 2, Original Snap Series, Fusion 2K, Fusion XC, Fusion APT Select Protect cover - SelectAir Max

Client has changing condition and may require modifications to the surface over time:

Zoned surface - Adapt, Adapt 2, Acute P3, Original Snap Series

360-degree zipper on cover - Adapt 2, Original Snap Series

Incontinent cover - Advance, Align, Allay, Adapt, Adapt 2, Acute, Acute P3, Original Snap Series

Client has an issue with moisture (wound drainage/incontinence):

Top cover is anti-microbial, fluid resistant and breathable - SelectAir Max, Fusion XC, Fusion 2K, Fusion APT, eMotion Recovery 5 anti-microbial base cover which provides incontinent protection for up to four hours, and aids in keeping skin cool and dry. It is removable, machine-washable, fluid-proof and fire-retardant - Advance, Align, Allay, Adapt, Adapt 2, Acute P3, Original Snap Series

Recovery 5 Ultra is zippered enclosure cover for the full mattress surface (and inserts) with 4-way stretch, is machine washable, and provides up to 6X more incontinent protection - Advance, Align, Allay, Adapt, Adapt 2, Acute P3, Original Snap Series

Client does not meet standard weight capacity limits:
